Sale of Mustard Oil in Jirania under PDS State Government working for public welfare: Food Minister

Consumers are now getting a variety of products at government fair price shops throughout the month which was not the case before. Commodities are available at government fair price shops early in the month. Now government fair price shops are also providing subsidized mustard oil.
