Integrated rubber processing unit inaugurated at Lambabill

Tribal welfare minister cum chairman of Tripura Rubber Plantation Corporation

(TRPC) Mevar Kumar Jamatia inaugurated an integrated rubber processing centre at Lambabill-Mainama Rubber Processing Centre complex on October 30. Chairman of Manu Block Advisory Committee Diba Chandra Hrangkhawl was also present there. Speaking on the occasion the tribal welfare minister hoped that this unit will help in opening up income opportunities for indigenous people in rural areas. The newly established unit has been funded by NABARD under Dhalai zone with an estimated cost of Rs. 32 lakh.

It was informed in the programme that next RPC will soon be inaugurated at Betchhara under Kumarghat subdivision. Managing director of TRPC Ltd., Agartala, Prasad Rao Vaddarap, BDO of Manu RD block Parimal Majumder, deputy manager of TRPC, Dhalai zone, Biswajit Das and other officials were also present there.
