The representative of TSECL informed, target has been set to provide power connections under Saubhgya Yojana among 12 thousand 133 families of this district. Representative of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs department reported in the meeting that a total of 20953 LPG connections under Ujjwala Yojana have been distributed to the BPL families. Of these, 7068 LPG connections in Sonamura subdivision, 8663 LPG connections in Bishalgarh and 5222 LPG connections in Jampuijala subdivision.
