



### **Training on scientific fish cultivation at Charilam**

Three day-long training camp on scientific fish cultivation has been started yesterday at Leela Deb memorial community hall of Charilam block. A total of 50 fish farmers from various villages and panchayats under Charilam block are getting training in this camp organized by Fisheries department.

### **Target set to cover 4 lakh families under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana : Food Minister**

Minister for Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs department Manoj Kanti Deb inaugurated new rural LPG distribution centre at Bagabasa of Sonamura Subdivision on November 11. On this occasion, a programme was organized in front of LPG godown adjacent to Bagbasa market. In this programme LPG connections under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana had been distributed to 30 poor families of this locality at free of cost. Apart from this, general gas connections been provided to two more families. Inaugurating the programme Food Minister Manoj Kanti Deb said that Ujjwala Yojana had been introduced in 2017 so that mothers could cook in smokeless atmosphere. On the

initiative taken by the present State government, LPG connections at free of cost under Ujjwala Yojana had already been distributed to 2 lakh poor families. He also informed that target has been set to cover 4 lakh families under this Yojana. Food Minister added, State government has taken initiative to purchase paddy from the farmers of the State at supporting price through FCI from the month of December and it would be supplied through public distribution system. State government has taken initiative to set up industries based on bamboo, rubber and pineapple. In the programme MLA Rampada Jamatia delivered his speech as chief guest. He stated the State government has taken initiatives to implement various welfare schemes of Union government. MLA Subhash Das addressing the programme as guest of honour urged cooperation of all for implementation of various development schemes of State government and Union government. The programme was presided over by Pradhan of Bagbassa panchayat Purnamohan Jamatia.
