

Special camps for PM flagship programmes

Special camps will be held on Prime Minister's flagship programmes in eight blocks of North Tripura district. Camps have been scheduled as – on November 30 in Khedachera ADC village, on December 7 in Damchera ADC village and on December 15 in Rahumchera ADC village of Damchera block; on November 30 in North Dasda ADC village, on December 7 in Dhanichera ADC village and on December 15 in Anandasagar ADC village of Dasda block; on November 30 in Sabowal YMA Hall, on December 7 in Belianchip YMA Hall and on December 15 in Manpui YMA Hall under Jampuihill block; on November 30 in Haflong gram panchayat, on December 7 in East Tilthoi gram panchayat and on December 15 in Bagabassa gram panchayat of Jubarajnar block; on November 30 in Baragol gram panchayat, on December 7 in Kadamtala gram panchayat and on December 15 in Churaibari gram panchayat of Kadamtala block; on November 30 in Sakaibari gram panchayat, on December 7 in Balichera ADC village and on December 15 in Gobindapur gram panchayat of Kalachera block; on November 30 in Shivanagar ADC village, on December 7 in Shantipur ADC village and on December 15 in Salkaham ADC village of Laljuri block; on November 30 in Chandra Halampara ADC village, on

December 7 in Jalebasa gram panchayat and on December 15 in North Padmabil gram panchayat of Panisagar block.

This information was given by DCM Subhash Datta during a press-meet held at the conference hall of North Tripura DM office yesterday. He also told the media that target for construction of individual toilets in North district under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) was fixed at 44, 774. So far work for 42, 242 toilets has been completed and work is going on for 2,532 toilets.

DCM Subhash Datta informed, under Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana treatment worth Rs. 5 lakh is available. For this purpose Golden Cards have been issued to 1, 554 people in North Tripura district. Under Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana Saubhagya scheme work has started for providing electricity connection to 17, 742 unelectrified families. Work for giving free gas connection to 43, 417 families is going on.

Assistance for mixed pisciculture in Rupaichari block

Mixed fish fingerlings have been distributed among four families of Rupaichari block under small scale fish farming scheme. 1640 fish fingerlings have been provided to each

family. This assistance has been provided to one family from each of Kathalchari, Baghmara, South Manu Bankul and East Sabroom ADC village. An amount of Rs. 20 thousand 660 has been spent for implementation of this programme. An area of 0.64 hectare waterbody has been covered under pisciculture.

Construction of market stalls under BADP scheme in Rupaichari block

Four schemes under Border Areas Development Programme have been implemented in Rupaichari block. An amount of Rs. 87 lakh 3 thousand 359 has been spent for this purpose. 10 market stalls have been constructed near Rupaichari block under this scheme for making the youths self-reliant through self-employment ventures. An amount of Rs.27 lakh 30 thousand 965 has been spent for this purpose. 5 new concrete classrooms for the students of Sonachandra Para JB School have been constructed spending an amount of Rs. 27 lakh 99 thousand 491. A new toilet (building) for the ladies has been constructed at Bankul new market. Rs.8 lakh 3 thousand has been spent for this purpose. Apart from this, handicraft industry centre has been constructed at Baishnabpur ADC village. Rs.23 lakh 69 thousand 903 has been spent for this purpose.

Meeting of Tepania Panchayat Samiti held

Meeting of Tepania Panchayat Samiti was held at the conference hall of Tepania Panchayati Raj Training Institute. Chairman of Tepania Panchayat Samiti Bijan Chakraborty, BDO of the block Aniruddha Roy, Pradhans of various panchayats, secretaries and officers from various departments were also present in the meeting chaired by MLA Rampada Jamatia.

At the outset of the meeting in regard to various development works of the block the BDO informed that till date 1 lakh 44 thousand 993 person-days has been generated in this block through MGNREGA. An average of 20 person-days has been generated. Additional 8 days work will be generated by December 15. He informed, till date an amount of Rs.68 lakh 46 thousand 827 has been spent under Panchayat Development Fund for implementation of various development works. He also informed that target has been set to construct 240 houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Till now 161 houses have been constructed. Moreover, toilets for 1176 APL families through Swachh Bharat Mission and 78 BPL families through MGNREGA have been constructed till now. In that meeting works PWD, DWS were also reviewed.

13,321 Persons enlisted under Construction Workers' Welfare Scheme in Sepahijala

A meeting of social justice related standing committee under Sepahijala Zilla Parishad was held at the conference hall of Sepahijala Zilla Parishad. The representative of social welfare and social education department informed that 79 Anganwadi centres of the district affected by storm will be renovated during the current financial year. Rs 50,000 will be spent for renovation of each Anganwadi centre. He also added that 1824 persons of the district have been enlisted under Pradhan Mantri Matruvandhana Yojana.

The representative of Education department informed that the students under age group of 6-13 year of various schools and the drop-out 361 students under age group of 14-18 have been admitted into the schools. The representative of labour department informed that Rs 41 lakh 87 thousand has been provided to 1588 students for education purpose under Construction Workers' Welfare Scheme. The families of two persons who died in sudden accident have been provided Rs 40,000/. Each of 4 construction –labourers have been provided Rs 5000 and a person has been provided Rs 4,900 as retirement assistance. 13,321 Labourers have been enlisted under Construction Workers' Welfare Scheme in

the district ill now. Shabhadhipati Fakharuddin Ahmed and other members of Zilla Parishad were present in the meeting of social justice standing committee.

An initiative has been taken to cultivate mustard seed in Karbook and Shilachhari blocks. With this target, production of mustard seed will be stated in 6 hectare land of Laugung, Chelagung and Powang bari ADC villager of Karbook block for distribution of mustard seed among the cultivators of Karbook and Shilachhari blocks under Karbook agricultural Siub division. During the current year 20.6 M.T potato seeds has been distributed among
