**Above two lakh mandays
generated under MGNREGA
in Mandai block**

During this current financial year till now 2 lakh 64 thousand 797 person-days have been generated through MGNREGA in Mandai block. Jobcard holders of different village committees have got work of an average man-days of 29.03. The BDO of Mandai block has informed this in a review meeting held on 12 November at Mandai BAC hall regarding different development works being taken by various departments under this block. He informed, during the financial year 2018-19 allocation for Panchayat Development Fund has been received Rs. 15 lakh 22 thousand 797. Out of this, an amount of Rs.10 lakh 34 thousand 222 has been spent for implementation of various development works. Mentioning the Swachh Bharat Mission scheme he informed, 12 village committees under this block have been declared Open Defecation Free (ODF). In

that review meeting chaired by MLA cum Chairman Dharendra Debbarma, Chairman of various village committees of the block, BDO of Mandai block N.S. Chakma along with officers of various departments and panchayat secretaries were present. Representative of Agriculture department informed in the meeting that fruit orchards of mangoes, lemon, mosambi, beetle-nut etc. have been created in 18 hectare land of this block through MGNREGA during this current financial year. Due to this 6077 person-days have been created. Apart from this, under the aegis of the department pineapple garden in 33.5 hectare and banana garden in 34.5 hectare land of this block will be raised. Representative of Social Welfare & Social Education department informed in the meeting that 178 Anganwadi centres are there under Mandai ICDS project. Total 4399 enrolled students are there in these Anganwadi centres. Representative of DWS department informed, construction work of pump-houses under 9 deep tube-well schemes are in progress. Out of these, construction work of two pump-houses have been completed. Official of ARD department informed in the meeting that financial assistance of Rs.3 thousand to each of 3 beneficiaries has been provided under goater scheme during this financial year.
